● **The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -**

1. The statement in its new form, comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
2. In the context of developing this statement, a special annex includes details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange, according to the types of commodities, countries, beneficiary companies, and the outlets through which these commodities were received. [Click to view](#).
3. There is a total of 36 sectors, which are broken down to 927 affiliated entities.
4. A portion from the oil revenues is used to finance the expenditure on the permitted budget chapters, in accordance to payment orders received from the Ministry of Finance based on the state's financial law, 1/12 from the expenditures of the past year 2021.
5. The requested data, regarding the amounts referred to the financial services controllers in Libyan cities, have been received, from the Ministry of Finance, which is attached as received, and further communication is being undertaken to develop this dataset.
6. The medical supply device has not disclosed yet in detail the types, quantities, distribution and beneficiaries of the medicines supplied.
7. Tax revenues kept declining during the period, as only 1.5 million LYD received during the month of October.
8. Customs revenues are also continued declining during the period, as the customs authority received an amount of 5 million LYD during the month of October, which is not commensurate with the value of open documentary credits and goods imported during the same period. Notably, the Ministry of Finance reported that, some ports and authorities did not transfer customs' revenues to the Ministry's accounts, according to the Minister's letter No. (2222/1م) dated 08/21/2022.
9. Revenues of both communications and domestic market revenues from the oil derivatives continued declining too, as no revenues were reported during the month of September.
10. During the period, total foreign currency revenues, amounted to 19 billion USD, of which 2.5 billion USD were from royalties for previous years, while total foreign exchange expenditures amounted to approximately 19.8 billion USD.
11. Transfers for the benefit of other entities with an amount of 310 million USD representing expenditures for the benefit of public entities (the Executive Authority for Special Flights (EACS) - Libyan Air Ambulance - Regulatory devices - Emergency Medicine Support Center - Libyan Center for Studies and Consultations in Cairo - Contributions of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs).
12. The amount of 157 million USD (other entities) represents payments of outstanding LCs for benefit of public sectors, namely: The Ministry of Health - the Ministry of Transportation - the Ministry of Defense - the Transportation Projects Board - the development of administrative centers authority - the Executive Authority for Special Flights - the Libyan Passport Authority - the Libyan Civil Aviation Authority - Public Security – the Man-Made River Project.
13. The fuel import bill has been paid directly by the National Oil Corporation (NOC) since Nov, 2021.
14. An urgent and temporary financial arrangement has been made for the National Oil Corporation, of a total amount of 34.3 billion LYD on 16/04/2022. 17 billion LYD were spent on the NOC, where 8.5 billion LYD were spent on Chapters (One and Two) accounts. Moreover, an amount of 8.5 billion LYD was executed for Chapter Three.
15. An amount of 15.3 billion dinars was transferred to the financial services controllers in all Libyan cities, representing 50% of the total salary section, and 21% of the total expenditure.
16. In light of implementing the CBL's strategy to provide cash liquidity to all commercial banks' branches, more than 35 billion LYD has so far been distributed to the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities and regions, during the period.
17. The number of collected cheques through the electronic clearing during the period, reached 2,550,600 cheques, with a total value of 55 billion LYD, that were implemented through 619 banks' branches out of 630 branches, distributed over the entire country.
18. Expenditure data excludes the salaries of month of October 2022.
