#### • The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -

- 1. The statement in its new form, comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
- In the context of developing this statement, a special annex includes details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange, according to the types of commodities, countries, beneficiary companies, and the outlets through which these commodities were received. <u>Click to view</u>. This is in addition to the weekly statement publishes by the Central Bank of Libya regarding LCs.
- 3. During the period, total foreign currency revenues, amounted to 9.8 billion USD, while total foreign exchange expenditures amounted to approximately 18.7 billion USD.
- 4. Tax and Customs revenues kept declining during the period, as revenues totaled 362 million dinars, or 0.8% of the total estimated revenues.
- 5. Revenues from the sale of fuel during the month of May amounted to (zero).
- 6. Salaries represent 71% of total expenditure, of which 9.3 billion LYD was transferred to the financial services controllers (as shown in the attached table), and it represents 41% of chapter one.
- 7. The fuel import bill has been paid directly by the National Oil Corporation (NOC) since Nov, 2021.
- 8. In light of implementing the CBL's strategy to provide cash liquidity to all commercial banks' branches, 43 billion LYD has so far been distributed to the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities and regions, during the period.
- 9. The number of collected cheques through the electronic clearing during the period, reached 1,098,976 cheques, with a total value of 27 billion LYD, that were implemented through 632 banks' branches, distributed over the entire country.
- The number of activated prepaid cards reached 1.866,333 million cards, and the total trading volume during the period was approximately
  3.5 billion LYD.
- 11. The total number of points of sale (POS) reached up to 47,445 devices, and the total trading volume is about 151.4 million LYD.
- 12. The number of activated e-wallets reached 138,871, and the total trading volume is about 18.5 million LYD.
