The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -

- 1. The statement in its new form comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
- 2. In the context of developing this statement, a special annex includes details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange, according to the types of commodities, beneficiary companies, and Countries through which these goods are supplied. Click to view. This is in addition to the weekly statement publishes by the Central Bank of Libya regarding LCs.
- 3. Oil revenues and royalties transferred to the Central Bank of Libya during the period amounted to \$11.6 billion, while foreign exchange expenditures until the end of June 2025 amounted to \$16.6 billion, with a deficit of \$5.0 billion, a slight increase of approximately \$300 million compared to the deficit level recorded in April 2025.
- 4. Revenues from the fees imposed on foreign exchange sales amounted to 10.3 billion LYD.
- 5. 65.0 billion LYD has so far been distributed through the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities during the period.
- **6.** The total number of cheques accepted during the period through the electronic clearing system reached 1,476,717 cheques with a total value of about 68.2 billion LYD implemented through 712 banking branches and clearing centers throughout the Libyan territory.
- 7. The number of POS issued during the period increased to 102,724, compared to the number of POS registered in 2024, which amounted to 76,356, an increase of 26,368 POS.
- 8. The number of activated cards reached 5,065,189 cards, and the number of card transactions on ATMs during the period reached 11,903,871 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 6.7 billion LYD. The number of card transactions on points of sale reached 85,047,640 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 11.9 billion LYD.
- **9.** The number of individual subscribers to the LYPAY and ONEPAY instant transfer services during the period reached 5,131,760 subscribers, while the number of merchant subscribers during the same period reached 115,754 subscribers. The number of transactions on the merchant instant transfer service reached 3,382,971 transactions, and the value of financial transactions via the instant transfer service reached 22.1 billion LYD.
- **10.** The number of subscribers to banking application services across banks reached 3,619,094. The total number of transactions through electronic applications during the period was 73,702,147, with a total financial transaction value of 125.2 billion LYD.
- 11. The number of e-wallets reached 181,544, with 5,888 e-wallet acceptance points. The number of transactions on the wallets during the period reached 333,020, and the total trading volume during the period reached 55.38 million LYD.
