• **The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -**

1. The statement in its new form comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
2. In the context of developing this statement, a special appendix is issued with this statement, including details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange by companies, countries of origin of goods and services, and beneficiary countries. [Click to view](#). This is in addition to the weekly statement publishes by the Central Bank of Libya regarding LCs.
3. Oil revenues and royalties transferred to the Central Bank of Libya during the period amounted to \$15.8 billion, while foreign exchange expenditures until the end of August 2025 amounted to \$21.7 billion, with a deficit of approximately \$5.9 billion, covered by returns on the Central Bank's investments in deposits and gold, and \$400 million from reserves
4. The Central Bank of Libya's total foreign assets amounted to approximately \$97.3 billion at the end of August, compared to approximately \$95.3 billion at the end of 2024.
5. Revenues from the fees imposed on foreign exchange sales amounted to 16.0 billion LYD.
6. 80.7 billion LYD has so far been distributed through the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities during the period.
7. The total number of cheques accepted during the period through the electronic clearing system reached 2,015,868 cheques with a total value of about 98.4 billion LYD implemented through 716 banking branches and clearing centers throughout the Libyan territory.
8. The number of POS issued during the period increased to 118,582, compared to the number of POS registered in 2024, which amounted to 76,356, an increase of 42,226 POS.
9. The number of activated cards reached 5,203,790 cards, and the number of card transactions on ATMs during the period reached 14,886,730 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 8.2 billion LYD. The number of card transactions on points of sale reached 116,029,534 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 16.2 billion LYD.
10. The number of individual subscribers to the LYPAY and ONEPAY instant transfer services during the period reached 5,506,096 subscribers, while the number of merchant subscribers during the same period reached 127,646 subscribers. The number of transactions on the merchant instant transfer service reached 4,934,974 transactions, and the value of financial transactions via the instant transfer service reached 32.0 billion LYD.
11. The number of subscribers to banking application services across banks reached 3,993,617. The total number of transactions through electronic applications during the period was 98,790,628, with a total financial transaction value of 169.0 billion LYD.
12. The number of e-wallets reached 183,560, with 5,667 e-wallet acceptance points. The number of transactions on the wallets during the period reached 411,333, and the total trading volume during the period reached 64.4 million LYD.
