The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -

- 1. The statement in its new form comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
- 2. In the context of developing this statement, a special appendix is issued with this statement, including details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange by companies, countries of origin of goods and services, and beneficiary countries. Click to view. This is in addition to the weekly statement publishes by the Central Bank of Libya regarding LCs.
- 3. Oil revenues and royalties transferred to the Central Bank of Libya during the period amounted to \$17.7 billion, while foreign exchange uses until the end of September 2025 amounted to \$23.7 billion, with a deficit of approximately \$6 billion, a slight increase from the previous month due to the decline in oil revenues and royalties. This deficit was covered by the Central Bank's investment returns from deposits, bond portfolios, and gold, achieving a primary surplus in the balance of payments amounting to \$1.7 billion. This supports the Central Bank's ability in the coming months to strengthen the value of the Libyan dinar.
- 4. The Central Bank of Libya's total foreign assets amounted to \$98.8 billion at the end of September, compared to \$95.5 billion at the end of 2024.
- 5. Revenues from the fees imposed on foreign exchange sales amounted to 17.7 billion LYD.
- 6. 82.4 billion LYD has so far been distributed through the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities during the period.
- 7. The total number of cheques accepted during the period through the electronic clearing system reached 2,232,261 cheques with a total value of about 114.8 billion LYD implemented through 717 banking branches and clearing centers throughout the Libyan territory.
- **8.** The number of POS issued during the period increased to 132,812, compared to the number of POS registered in 2024, which amounted to 76,356, an increase of 56,456 POS.
- 9. The number of activated cards reached 5,267,283 cards, and the number of card transactions on ATMs during the period reached 16,616,921 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 8.9 billion LYD. The number of card transactions on points of sale reached 133,345,603 transactions, with a total trading volume during the period of 18.5 billion LYD. The total financial value used via electronic payment cards reached 27.4 billion LYD.
- **10.** The number of individual subscribers to LYPAY and ONEPAY instant transfer services during the period reached 5,698,313 subscribers, while the number of merchant subscribers during the same period reached 131,576 subscribers. The number of transactions on the merchant instant transfer service reached 5,511,081 transactions, and the value of financial transactions via the instant transfer service reached 35.9 billion LYD.
- 11. The number of subscribers to banking application services across banks reached 3,491,272. The total number of transactions through electronic applications during the period was 111,173,602, with a total financial transaction value of 188.2 billion LYD.
- 12. The number of e-wallets reached 177,376, with 5,893 e-wallet acceptance points. The number of transactions on the wallets during the period reached 449,506, and the total trading volume during the period reached 68.0 million LYD.
