- **The Central Bank of Libya (CBL), as it publishes this data, affirms the following: -**

1. The statement in its new form comes within the framework of the CBL's efforts to achieve the highest rates of disclosure and transparency, in response to local and international requests. The CBL continues its efforts to develop this statement in coordination with related institutions.
2. In the context of developing this statement, a special appendix is issued with this statement, including details of commercial banks' uses of foreign exchange by companies, countries of origin of goods and services, and beneficiary countries. [Click to view](#). This is in addition to the statement issued periodically by the Central Bank of Libya regarding LCs.
3. Oil revenues and royalties transferred to the Central Bank of Libya during the period amounted to \$20.7 billion, while foreign currency uses until the end of November 2025 amounted to \$28.5 billion, with a deficit of approximately \$7.8 billion. The increase in the value of the deficit during the period is due to the decline in oil revenues supplied to the bank since September. This deficit was reimbursed by the returns on the Central Bank's investments in deposits, the bond portfolio and gold, and achieving an increase in foreign assets of \$2.2 billion.
4. The Central Bank of Libya's total foreign assets amounted to \$99.4 billion at the end of November, compared to \$95.5 billion at the end of 2024.
5. Revenues from the fees imposed on foreign exchange sales amounted to 21.4 billion LYD.
6. 94.0 billion LYD has so far been distributed through the branches of commercial banks in all Libyan cities during the period.
7. The number of checks accepted through the electronic clearing system during the period amounted to 2,768,391 checks, with a total value of 128.8 billion LYD, executed through 718 bank branches and clearing centers across the entire Libyan territory.
8. The Point-of-Sales (POS) witnessed a notable increase compared to October 2025, as their number rose by 8,570 POS, bringing the total number of POS to 150,019 in November.
9. The number of active cards reached 5,225,788 cards, and card transactions at point-of-sale terminals increased compared to October by 31,296,313 transactions, reaching 194,790,143 transactions in November. Meanwhile, the volume of transactions at POS rose compared to October by 4.1 billion LYD, bringing the total to 26.2 billion LYD in November. Card transactions at ATMs also increased compared to October by 1,088,454 transactions, reaching 19,361,346 transactions in November. In addition, the value of card transactions at ATMs increased compared to October by 0.5 billion LYD, reaching 10.1 billion LYD in November.
10. The number of individual subscribers to the instant transfer services LYPAY and ONEPAY reached 6,610,797 subscribers during the period. The number of instant transfer operations increased compared to October by 2,094,008 operations, bringing the total to 8,954,296 operations in November. The transaction volume related to instant transfer operations also increased, reaching 55.9 billion LYD in November, an increase of 12.7 billion LYD compared to October.
11. The number of subscribers to the banking group's application services reached 3,681,591 subscribers, and the number of application transactions increased during November to reach 137,343,108 transactions, achieving an increase of 12,966,220 transactions compared to October. The transaction volume also grew to reach 236 billion LYD in November; an increase of 26.5 billion LYD compared to the previous month.
12. The number of electronic wallets reached 183,435 wallets, and the number of acceptance points for electronic wallets reached 6,069 acceptance points. The number of wallet transactions recorded a notable increase, reaching 547,641 transactions during November, with a growth of 53,349 transactions compared to October. The transaction volume of the wallets also rose to 79.6 million LYD in November, registering an increase of 6.1 million LYD compared to October.
13. Electronic payment instruments witnessed an unprecedented increase during November, as the total transaction volume of electronic payments reached 43.8 billion LYD, bringing the total transaction volume of electronic payments to 328.0 billion LYD during 2025.
